JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (Oral)

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the criteria for out of turn allotment of house.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the present writ petition is of the year 1997 and the petitioner is not in her contact.
3. Since the dispute in the present case is pertaining to house allotment and the present writ petition is of the year 1997, the petitioner might have retired by now because the petition itself was filed about 27 years ago.
4. In view of the aforesaid position, the present writ petition is dismissed.
5. However, in case any cause of action still survives, then the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of the present writ petition.
