1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 25.07.1997 passed by the respondent while exercising the powers of reviewing.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is of the year 1997 and no interim order has been passed in favour of the petitioner and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect inspite of the report of the registry that the counsel for the petitioner has been informed.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives.
5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
