Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.123 dated 28.11.2023, under Sections 353, 186, 506 & 149 IPC at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 15.02.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.02.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhajan, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.02.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
