Prayer in the present petition is for directing the official respondents to demarcate the land of the petitioner trust falling in Khewat No.470, Khatauni No.606 having Khasra No.604 measuring 29 kanals 9 marlas as per Jamabandi of year 2021-2022 of Village Dayalpura Bhaika, Tehsil Phul, District Bathinda of which the petitioner is owner in possession despite the representations (Annexures P-2 to P-5) made by petitioner trust to the official respondents, the respondents failed to demarcate the land of the petitioner as mentioned above, as the inaction on part of the respondents is totally illegal, unjust, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of Article 14 & 21 of the Constitution of India.

It has been submitted by counsel for the petitioner that though the representations have been filed time and again but no action has been taken till date. However, learned State counsel on instructions has submitted that the State authorities have already initiated the necessary action for demarcation of the land. However, due to the law and order problem, some more time is required for carrying out the necessary demarcation as prayed for. He submits that the demarcation would be completed within four weeks.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the State to carry out the demarcation as undertaken before this Court within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. The petitioner would be associated while carrying out the demarcation and final report to the petitioner be supplied after carrying out demarcation. Petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedies as per law in case of his having any further cause of action.
