Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to hold detailed and impartial enquiry into the embezzlement and misuse of Panchayat funds by Sarpanch, who in connivance with residents of other Village being her close aides, and under the garb of development in the village has been misappropriating the funds and despite repeated complaints, the authorities are willfully avoiding the enquiry in that regard. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to constitute a Special Investigation Team (SIT) under the supervision of Inspector General or Director General of Punjab Police for investigating the complaint and further taking necessary action against Gram Panchayat Kharodi and Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Kharodi.

Learned State counsel has stated that the enquiry against respondent No.4 has already been completed and nothing was filed against respondent No.4 and as such nothing survives in the present petition which has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to controvert the submissions made by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy as per law in case he is aggrieved of the enquiry conducted by the respondents.
