HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that he should have been granted promotion to the post of Superintendent Grade-II w.e.f. 11.08.1987 and thereafter to the post of Superintendent Grade-I w.e.f. 16.08.1990.

2. As per the affidavit filed by the Mr. Surinder Pal, Joint Secretary, Punjab Vidhan Sabha Secretariat, Chandigarh dated 24.09.2019, the said benefits have already been given to the petitioner during the pendency of the present writ petition vide order dated 19.01.2000 (Annexure R-1/1).

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3. It has been further mentioned in the affidavit that the petitioner by way of compassion has also been given further promotion as Deputy Secretary prior to his retirement.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to dispute the said fact.

5. Once all the benefits being claimed in the present writ petition has already been extended to the petitioner, no further order is required to be passed in the present writ petition and the present writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

6. It is made clear that in case any of the grievance of the petitioner still subsists even after the passing of the order granting promotion, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation and in case any representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents will be bound to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same dealing with all the claims raised therein by giving due reasons either for accepting or for rejecting.
