VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner vide his representation dated 31.12.2021 (Annexure P-7).
2. It is not in dispute that as per the advance copy of the reply supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner by respondent No. 3, in paragraph 7, it has been stated that the petitioner had secured 74.8 marks (34.8 in written examination+ 10 height marks+ 10 high jumps+ 10 chin up marks+ 10 race marks), whereas the cutoff marks of last selected candidate in the general category, in which the petitioner applied, was 76.2 marks and for waiting list, cutoff was 75.4 marks.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the petitioner does not want to press the present petition and the same be disposed of as such.
4. In view of the same, present petition is disposed of having been not pressed.
