This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction quashing the order dated 03.01.1996 issued by respondent no.1 as well as the order dated 24.10.1996 issued by respondent no.2 placing all government houses located at Muktsar at the disposal of respondent no.2.
2. Learned State counsel has stated that in the present case no interim order was passed and the present petition in all likelihood has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not able to get in touch with the petitioner and at this stage, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause survives.
