1. The prayer made in the present petition which was filed in the year 2001 is to grant appointment on compassionate grounds.
2. Learned State counsel refers to para No.4 of the written statement which reads thus:-

“4. Para No.4 admitted to the extent that the Punjab Govt. Has issued these instructions that the request for compassionate ground appointment of the dependent member are to be made within a period of 6 months from the date of death of the Govt. Employee. It is further submitted that as per the definition of ‘Family’ described in para 3(c) of Rule 6.17 of Pb. C.S.R. Vol.II (Annexure R-2) ‘Sons upto the age of 25 years’ are covered under the dependent members of the deceased employee. Petitioner’s age is 30 years as per certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar vide his letter

No. M.A.-1/MC-2/5113 dated 21.05.2001 (Annexuyre R-1). Hence, the plaintiff has crossed the age limit of 25 years as prescribed in above rule. Therefore he is not entitled for the post.”

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
