Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to release the land of petitioner measuring 16 kanals 5^{4/5} marla comprised in Khewat No.30, 399, 859 & 948 situated within the revenue estate of Village Ghallu, Hadbast No.138, Tehsil and District Fazilka, from attachment as attached vide Rapat No.42 dated 28.09.2021 and Rapat No.88 dated 12.10.2021 recorded in pursuance of letter No.486 dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-9) issued by Excise and Taxation Officer, Abohar (respondent No.2.) on the basis of alleged assessment order dated 28.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed under Section 29 of Punjab VAT Act, 2005 and order dated 23.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) passed under Section 32(3) of the Act ibid in respect of M/s Simar Enterprises (VAT No.03132187865), Nihal Khera, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka as the petitioner has no concern with the said firm. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.5 and 6 to release the due amount of compensation along with upto date prevalent interest to the petitioner in respect of part of land, out of above said land, acquired by NHAI as depicting in Rapat No.325 vide order dated

28.02.2022 as reflecting in the copy of Jamabandi for the Year 2018-19 (Annexure P-2).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the respondents-authorities.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. If any such representation/application is filed by the petitioner within ten days from the date of receipt of copy of this order, then the respondents-authorities would decide the same as per law expeditiously, preferably, within one month from the date of its filing.
