JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of award dated 17.10.1997 (Annexure P-4) whereby Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court had answered reference against the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance of petitioner would be redressed if he is paid lumpsum compensation.

3. Faced with this, Mr. P.K. Mutneja, Senior Advocate submits that respondent would pay compensation as determined by this Court.

4. Considering the length of service and the fact that petitioner at present is 60 years old, this Court finds it appropriate to direct the respondent to pay a sum of Rs. 1,25,000/- to the petitioner.
