Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the letter dated 27.07.1998 (Annexure P-8) issued by respondent No.3 and for quashing the Notification dated 19.05.1998 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.1. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to release and grant revised pay of Rs.5000-8100/- to the petitioners along with due arrears w.e.f. the date of designation of respective petitioners as Junior Assistants. Another prayer has been made to restrain the respondents from effecting any recoveries from the pay of the petitioners, which have been granted to them in pursuance of the Notification dated 16.01.1998 (Annexure P-5) issued by respondent No.1, which was adopted by respondent – Board vide order No.286 of 1998 dated 30.03.1998 (Annexure P-6). Further prayer has been made to restrain the respondents from effecting any recoveries from the pay of the petitioners validly granted to them and to stay the operation of Notification dated 19.05.1998 (Annexure P-7).



There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners from the last three consecutive dates.

Notices issued to petitioners No.1 to 6, 8 to 10 have been received back unserved with the report that they have retired from service. Notice issued to petitioner No.7 has been received back unserved with the report that she is on long leave and notice issued to petitioner No.11 has been received back unserved with the report that he has expired.

In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

However liberty is granted to petitioners to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
