Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the No Confidence Motion dated 09.10.2000 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the private respondents No.6 to 12 and subsequent action taken by respondent No.5 vide Annexure P-9 dated 02.11.2000, whereby in violation of Section 25, respondent No.5 have fixed the meeting; and a writ of prohibition restraining the respondents No.4 to 12 to convene the meeting of No Confidence Motion before the expiry of the period stipulated in the Punjab Municipal Act, 1911.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has died and thus, nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication and become infructuous.
