1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to retain the seniority given to the petitioner and also for issuing of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 31.08.1998.
