1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC for withdrawal of the main case on the basis of settlement between the parties.
2. A perusal of the application would show that the main case is listed for 24.09.2024. It has been prayed in the application that the applicants-petitioners seek to withdraw the main writ petition in view of the said settlement.
3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that the matter has been settled and he has no objection in case the date of hearing in



the main case is preponed from 24.09.2024 to today and same is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.

4. In view of the same, the present application i.e. CM-8754-CWP-2024 is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 24.09.2024 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.
