1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 14.07.2023 passed in CWP-14726-2023.

2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. R.S. Dhillon, Director General Elementary Education Haryana, Panchkula has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 14.07.2023 passed in CWP-14726-2023 has been complied with and the respondent has made the payment to which the petitioners were entitled.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that full payment has not been paid to the petitioners. On the contrary, even the ACP scale which was earlier granted is now stated to have been withdrawn.



5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to challenge the action of the respondent and the order passed by the respondent now by availing alternate remedy.
