1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 31.01.2024 (Annexure P-11) whereby respondent has freezed a sum of ₹1,75,000/- lying in his account.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents, at the outset, submits that bank has de-freezed account of the petitioner and he is at liberty to join service but he cannot be treated on duty without joining.
3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
4. The present petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to join his service.
