NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits i.e. pension, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund etc. to the petitioner along with interest.

2. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment to get instructions from the petitioner.
