This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 17.11.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-25842-2023.

Counter affidavit of the petitioner has been filed by learned counsel for the petitioner today in the Court. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced the copy of letter received by the department communicating to him the order passed by the Writ Court. It is further submitted that the necessary order has been passed in compliance of the said order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of said certified copy as sent by the High Court.

Although, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had sent the copy of order to the respondent and as per docket, said order

was received by him, but he had not passed the order within a period of six weeks, therefore, the respondent is in contempt.

However, since the substantial compliance of the order has already been done, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
