The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.184 dated 02.11.2023 under Sections 323, 324, 295, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.02.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
