PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 12.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) by protecting their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Jatinder Pal Singh, PPS, DSP Dakha, District Ludhiana has been filed in the Registry. The same is taken on record.
3. The stand of the State has been culled out in para No.7 which reads as under:-

“That the petitioners feel no danger to their lives and liberty from private respondents. They are residing together as husband and wife. They do not want any police protection. So there is no threat perception to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. In these circumstances, it is prayed that the present petition may kindly be dismissed.”

4. Counsel for the petitioners records his satisfaction to the same.
5. In view of above, no further order is warranted and the present petition stands disposed off.
6. Ordered accordingly.
