The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeks grant of parole for a period of 15 days to attend the kriya / bhog ceremony of his mother, which is fixed for today, i.e. 21.02.2024.

[2] Upon advance notice, Mr. Kewal Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions, confirms the aforesaid fact.

[3] Considering the fact that Bhog ceremony of the mother of the petitioner is admittedly fixed for today i.e. 21.02.2024, the petitioner is permitted to attend the same while in custody. The Superintendent of the Jail concerned shall ensure that the petitioner is able to attend the Bhog ceremony of his mother, fixed for today i.e. 21.02.2024 under the police custody. The petitioner shall be brought back to the jail by 5.00 p.m. on the same day.
