1. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to confirm the Probationary A.S.Is (Operators) appointed in 1986, 1988, 1989 and 1993 against 25% quota reserved for Probationers by counting year to year posts and to give consequential benefits.

2. Mr. Pawan Kumar, DAG, Punjab submits that in view of directions of this Court in different writ petitions as well as introduction of Punjab Police Act, 2007, 4 cadres of officers have been carved out. Seniority list has been prepared. Six of the petitioners have retired after serving as Deputy Superintendent of Police. 4 out of 10 petitioners are serving with respondent as Inspectors. The grievance of the petitioners stands redressed.

3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.

4. There is no representation on behalf of petitioners, thus, petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
