Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying for quashing of FIR No.122 dated 21.11.2017, under Sections 279, 304-A & 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, including judgment of conviction as well as order of sentence dated 05.07.2019, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Fazilka, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties, i.e. petitioner as well as respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition be disposed off with liberty to raise all his pleas before learned Sessions Judge, where his appeal is still pending on 20.01.2024.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. Also observed that there would be no harm if learned Appellate Court takes into consideration the factum of compromise entered into between the parties, i.e. petitioner as well as respondent No.2, while deciding the appeal against conviction.
