By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for quashing of order dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P.3) passed by learned trial Court whereby bail earlier granted to petitioner in case FIR No.42 dated 01.05.2022 under Section 379-B(2) IPC and Sections 188, 411 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, was cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention towards the fact that the petitioner had even sought exemption of appearance but trial Court dismissed the application. Learned counsel also contends that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and the next date of hearing is stated to be 01.03.2024.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

This petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 01.03.2024 and apply for bail. On his surrender, the Court will proceed against the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C

and after disposal of those proceedings, shall admit the petitioner to bail. However, it is made clear that till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested in view of the warrants of arrest issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
