1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that petitioners have secured more marks than the last selected candidate in general category and even as of now, more than 200 posts out of 1554 post of nurse/staff nurse as advertised are still lying vacant, hence, the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment of those vacant post.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that without even filing any representation, the present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner and in case, the grievance, has been raised before the authorities concerned, the appropriate decision will be

taken by the concerned authorities within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to except the claim of the petitioner, the relief will be granted otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned while passing the speaking order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to raise all the grievance to the authorities concerned by filing appropriate representation.
