According to the petitioner, this is the second petition seeking regular bail.

However, Mr. Vikram Rathore, Advocate appeared for the complainant has placed on record copies of two orders, one order dated 12.10.2023 passed in CRM-M-43080-2023; and another dated 16.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-12695-2023, so as to contend that this is the third petition as the earlier two petitions were dismissed as withdrawn.

3. Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he was not aware about the dismissal of the two petitions as withdrawn, as he was informed by the family members of the petitioner that it is only second petition.
