Prayer made in the present writ petition was for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to provide Single Point Separate Domestic Electric Connection of 400 KVA to Redwud Foundation for Tower A, B and C Redwud Residency, Sector 78, Greater Faridabad in view of the representation dated 24.01.2023 and 01.02.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-5).

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 to 4/Distribution Licensee submits that as per instructions received from SDO OPS/Divn. K/Kalan DHBVN, Faridabad, vide Memo No.3041 dated 22.02.2024, a settlement has already been arrived at between the Distribution Licensee and the petitioner Residents Welfare Association and that 310 individual electricity connections have already been released to the residents of M/s Redwood Residency, Sector 78, Faridabad, till date. He contends that the process has already been initiated and certain dues which are payable will be recovered in installments.
