LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents No.2 to 4 for implementation of order dated 13.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 14 of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (SARFAESI Act), 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the State submits that this writ petition seeking compliance of order under Section 14 of SARFAESI Act is rendered infructuous because as per information received from Bank itself, the loan account in question stands closed and all dues have been cleared by borrower. Communication dated 04.09.2023 furnished in court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he does not have any instructions in this respect.

4. Be that as it may, we do not find any justification for continuance of present proceedings, in view of specific statement made by learned counsel for the State.

5. Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with liberty to petitioner to file appropriate application within four weeks in case, any incorrect fact has been set forth before this Court.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
