This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking
preponement of the date of hearing from 08.07.2024 to some early date.

Counsel for the State pleads no objection.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is
allowed and the main case is taken on board today itself.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.68 dated
27.02.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406
and 420 of IPC, 1860 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983
(Sections 467, 468, 471, 201 and 506 of IPC, 1860 added later on) at

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2. Petitioner is alleged to have cheated the complainant of Rs.6 lakhs on the pretext of sending him abroad.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that out of 6 lakhs, petitioner has already deposited Rs.1.4 lakhs before his arrest in the account of complainant and is ready to settle the matter amicably. Challan stands presented.
4. Keeping in view the nature of allegations and the fact that petitioner is ready to settle the matter amicably, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. Trial Court is directed to call both the parties and referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre to explore the possibility of amicable settlement.
5. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
