VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 26.10.1995 passed by respondent No. 4 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has died and the office of the senior counsel is not in touch with the LRs of the petitioner and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the LRs of the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to them.
