It can be safely presumed that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present petition. Even otherwise, the grievance raised by the petitioners in the present petition is that upon the promotion of the petitioners to the post of Head Teacher/Central Head Teacher, they have not been granted increment and therefore, the respondents are under obligation to grant the increment at the time of promotion to the post of Head Teacher.

The respondents have filed their reply wherein they have stated that keeping in view the Instructions dated 23.07.1957, the petitioners are getting the pay-scale of Rs.1640-2495/- working as a J.B.T Teacher whereas the pay-scale of the Head Teacher and Central Head Teacher is Rs.1410-

2460/- and Rs.1500-2640/- respectively and as, the petitioners are already getting a higher pay-scale they are entitled for, they are not entitled for any arrears and interest.

Be that as it may as of now, nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to press the present petition despite notice by the Registry hence, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
