1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 07.02.2024 (Annexure P-10) passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Gurugram whereby relief sought by the petitioner for grant of interim injunction has been declined.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appeal is pending but it is necessary that proper directions be issued to the Tehsildar Farrukh Nagar, District Gurugram to make an entry in the revenue record about the pendency of the present litigation to avoid multiplicity of litigation.
3. When faced with this situation whether said plea was taken in the grounds of appeal the counsel for the petitioner submits that copy of the grounds of appeal is not annexed but he would be satisfied if his application for interim injunction pending before the learned trial Court for 26.02.2024 is decided on the same day.
4. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the application filed by the petitioner for interim injunction within a period of 03 days positively, from the next date of hearing i.e. 26.02.2024 fixed before the trial Court.
