1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of orders dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-10) and 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-16) whereby petitioners have been blacklisted.
2. Mr. Shiv Kumar, Advocate submits that respondents, on the one hand are not adjudicating appeals of the petitioners and on the other hand, have blacklisted both of them for default, if any, on part of petitioner No.1.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service.

5. With the consent of both sides, the present petition is taken up for final adjudication.
6. Learned State counsel assures the Court that appeals of the petitioners would be adjudicated in accordance with law within seven working days from today.
7. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
