Prayer in this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 197 dated 02.12.2021, registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 201 and 34 of IPC at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of Surinderpal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Bholath, Kapurthala has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel contends that similarly placed co-accused Chanveer Singh and Harjot Singh @ Jot have already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-12) passed in CRM-M-7187-2023 and CRM-M-12799-2023, respectively.

4. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contentions. He concedes that the case of petitioner is at parity with co-accused Chanveer Singh.

5. A perusal of custody certificate would reveal that the petitioner is in custody for the last 02 years, 02 months and 25 days, with no other case pending against him.

6. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, particularly on the ground of parity and for all the reasons as have been discussed in the order dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-12) by this Court, but without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to regular bail and is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
