This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 05.08.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-17115-2022.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Compliance affidavit dated 03.10.2023 on behalf of the respondent has been filed by learned counsel for the respondent today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the respondent is not taking any kind of coercive action against the petitioner, in any manner whatsoever.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
