The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue an appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. A further prayer has been made to direct the respondents No.3 and 4 for taking appropriate action against respondents No.5 and 6, who are habitual of moving false and frivolous complaints against the petitioner.

2. On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and on instructions from ASI Guriqbal Singh, submits that certain complaints were filed by respondents No.5 and 6 against the present petitioner. However, after inquiry, no truth was found in the said applications/representations and the said applications/representations have been ordered to be filed by the police officials. He further contends that no inquiry is pending against the present petitioner.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required in the present petition and the same is ordered to be disposed off.
