1. In the present petition, grievance of the petitioners is that though, the petitioners were working on the post of conductor with the respondent-department from the year 2008 but during the service period for certain time the petitioner were not given extension in service, which break period needs to be regularized so that the petitioners can claim continuity in service especially, when the said relief has already been given to the similarly situated employees.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P/2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P/2) has been received from the petitioners and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
