SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. On 15.03.2024, this Court passed the following order:-

*“Despite repeated requests over the years, parties have not supplied copies of paper-books, which have been reported to have been burnt in fire.
Counsel for the appellant submits that he does not have a copy. On his request, list on 29.04.2024, i.e., the date already fixed.
In case, the paper-books are not supplied by the next date, this Court shall be constrained to pass appropriate orders.
Photocopy of this order be placed on the file of connected cases.”*

2. Despite grant of numerous opportunities, copy of the paper-book has not been supplied by either of the parties. It seems that they are not interested in pursuing the matter.

3. Appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the appellant to seek revival of the appeal after completing the record of this Court.
