Prayer made in the present petition is for directing respondents No.2 and 3 not to seize the vehicle of the petitioner i.e. Truck bearing Registration No.PB-04AA-6566.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has already transposed the loan and as on date, he has no liability towards respondents No.2 and 3.

There is no representation on behalf of the said respondents to controvert or verify the above aspect.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to respondents No.2 and 3 to seek revival of the present case, in case the above statement made by counsel for the petitioner is found to be factually incorrect or false; or any dues still remain to be recovered from the petitioner.
