This petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents and 5 as the petitioners have performed marriage against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the State has filed Status report by way of affidavit of Sukhwinder Pal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar, Gurdaspur in compliance of order dated 19.04.2024 passed by this Court, the same is taken on record. The relevant paragraph is reproduced below :-

‘That it is humbly submitted that in compliance of above said order, the report has been obtained from SHO Police Station Dinanagar. SHO Police Station Dinanagar has submitted in its report that the petitioners got recorded their statement to ASI Satinder Pal Singh of Incharge, Police Post Bariar (Police Station Dinanagar) on 29.03.2024 stating that at

present there is no apprehended threat to the petitioners and they do not want any security. The statements of petitioners are annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T & R- 2/T.'

In view of the specific pleadings in the status report to the extent that now there is no threat apprehension, no further directions are called for.

The petition is dismissed being devoid of merits.
