VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing Rule 14 of the Punjab Public Works Department (Irrigation Branch) Patwaris State Service Class-III Rules, 1955.
