Main case

3. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 22.2.2024, the following
order was passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon
order dated 16.12.2023 passed in CRM-M-63384-2023
and order dated 20.12.2023 passed in CRM-M-59918-
2023 by this Court, to contend that the petitioner is
similarly placed.

Notice of motion for 11.03.2024.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall join the
investigation and would come present as and when called
for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to
interim bail on his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds

to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.
The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

4. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to her by ASI Raj Pal, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is fully co-operating with the investigation process and he is not required for any further custodial investigation.
5. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed** and order dated 22.2.2024 is, hereby, made absolute.
