Prayer in the present petition is for directing the official respondents to remove the illegal encroachment made by the private respondents on the main street of the Village, whereby the private respondents had constructed a septic tank on the main street of the Village, after damaging the same. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.6/Sarpanch for not taking any action on the representation given by the petitioner and thereby for not performing her duties and functions. Further prayer has been made for directing official respondents to decide and take necessary action upon the representation/legal notice dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner within a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has issued legal notice dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) before respondents No.2 and 3 but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondents till date.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Fazilka is directed to decide the legal notice dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) issued by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
