The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.421 dated 07.11.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 34 IPC and Section 120-B IPC (Added later on) registered at P.S. Old Faridabad, District Faridabad, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 19.03.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 25.04.2024 of Mr. Sahilendra Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sarai, Faridabad in the court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 19.03.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 19.03.2024 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
