JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to release him regular pensionary and other retiral benefits.
2. Mr. Pawan Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, at the outset, submits that during the pendency of present petition, the competent authority has released leave encashment as well as pension. The relevant papers have been sent to the Treasury and petitioner would be released pension in due course.
3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.

4. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if pension and other retiral benefits are not actually released within two months from today.
