The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside impugned order dated 24.05.1994 (Annexure P-11) passed by the learned Collector, Jalandhar and impugned order dated 10.09.1996 (Annexure P-13) passed by the learned Commissioner, Jalandhar Division.

2. A perusal of order sheets reveals that on 20.05.2024, the following order was passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

"It has been submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that the arguing counsel appearing
