1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the trial Court to decide the application under Section 151 CPC (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner in the light of the order dated 03.08.2023 (Annexure P-10) passed by this Court.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that vide order dated 03.08.2023 (Annexure P-10) passed in CR No.3532 of 2022, the revision petition was allowed and the order dated 12.01.2022 passed by the trial Court was set aside and the learned trial Court was directed to decide the application afresh in accordance with law but the application is not yet decided and many adjournments have been granted. He further submits that petitioner would be satisfied if that application is disposed of with a time bound manner by the trial Court. The next date of hearing before the trial Court is 24.02.2024.
3. If notice is given to the other side it may further delay the disposal of case and may further put financial burden upon respondents.
4. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the

said application filed by the petitioner under Section 151 CPC (Annexure P-3) within a period of one month, positively, from the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court.

5. Petition stands disposed of.
