1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent-commission to allow the petitioner to appear in the examination for Group-1 post going to be held on 18.02.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had applied in Category No.8 for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) and he was having a higher merit and was not considered for the aforesaid category.

3. However, at this stage, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, appearing on behalf of respondent-Commission on instructions from Mr. Chirag Aggarwal, ADA, HSSC, has submitted that subsequently a corrigendum was issued and according to the same, as per the qualification of the petitioner, he was to be considered for the post of Junior Engineer in Category No.30, Group-II and now he has been considered in the aforesaid category and with regard to the same in case he is on merit then further process will be followed.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the

statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed

of.

5. In view of the aforesaid position and statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of.
