CRR(F)0210-2020 (O&M)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that both the parties have effected a compromise and a decree of divorce with mutual consent under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has already been passed by the learned Family Court, Samrala, District Ludhiana, as per its judgment and decree dated 13.12.2023. A copy of the aforesaid judgment

and decree has also been given by learned counsel for the petitioners in Court today, which is taken on record.
